The Asian Food Safety and Security Association (AFSA) is a voluntary, non-profit, charitable organization established in 2010. The 5<sup>th</sup> general assembly of Bangladesh-Japan Association for Science and Technology (BJAST) at Dhaka in 2010 decided to establish the Asian Food Safety and Security Association (AFSA). ## **CONFERENCE OVERVIEW**

This conference will address key issues related to food safety and food security. The plenary sessions and concurrent symposia will examine the major challenges facing Asia, including ensuring food safety in the development of new food products and processing technologies, the internationalization of food trade, the safety of foods derived from biotechnology, microbiological risks, and the emergence of new and antibiotic-resistant pathogens. Discussions will also focus on directing research toward high-risk areas, implementing targeted interventions, and establishing appropriate risk levels and priority pathogens or diseases.

The two-day scientific program, including oral and poster presentations, will offer multiple opportunities for experts and participants to exchange ideas on critical food safety and food

security issues. Representatives from governmental and international organizations, industry, and universities will share insights, address challenges, and discuss strategies and collaborative initiatives to strengthen global efforts to ensure safe food for improved health and environmental sustainability, particularly in developing countries.
